Mrs. Cavalli's Class Supply List

Our class will work off of the General Kindergarten Supply list. I have added additional items at the bottom of the page.

- A book bag (large enough to hold a folder and a lunch box)
- 6 large Elmer's glue sticks
- 4 24 pack box of Crayola Crayons
- Crayola Classic Colors Broad Tip markers (1 box)
- Craoyola Classic Thin Tip Markers (1 box)
- 2 packages of 4 Expo Dry Erase Markers (preferably all black)
- 2 boxes of tissues
- Your child will also need a lunch box.

Additional Supplies for our Classroom:

- 1 sturdy, PLASTIC pocket folder (pocket along the bottom)
- 1bottles of Elmer's Glue
- 1 plastic pencil box (that snaps closed)
- 1 box sandwich size Ziploc bags
- 1 containers of antibacterial wipes (Clorox or Lysol)
- \$20 in a sealed envelope with your child's name. This money will be used to purchase classroom prizes and for special projects, such as buying caterpillars.
- A spare set of clothing (including undergarments), each item should be labeled and placed in a ziploc
