# EASTCHESTER HIGH SCHOOL

Located in Westchester County, nestled between the Hutchinson River and the Bronx River, the Eastchester community was settled in 1664. The Eastchester Union Free School District was incorporated formally in 1892 and has since been serving its community of professionals, tradesmen and executives through innovative teaching design and a strong focus on the whole child.

Eastchester High School is a four-year comprehensive school program with an academic curriculum that has been nationally recognized for its excellence by the U.S. Department of Education. The majority of students enroll in a four-year college preparatory program, with others pursuing associates degrees, military service or employment. Students are offered numerous opportunities to participate in Advanced Placement (AP) courses in all content areas, as well as an Advanced Science Research program and the W.I.S.E. internship program. A wide array of extracurricular clubs and athletic opportunities, as well as winter and spring concerts and theater/dance productions to showcase student talent outside of the classroom, round out the EHS student experience. The Eastchester community supports a strong emphasis on community service and content-specific field trips, both nationally and internationally, that broaden the students' understanding of the connection between the curriculum and a increasingly important global perspective.

## CURRICULAR HIGHLIGHTS

- ◆ In 2021-2022, 38 students participated in the Advanced Science Research Program. Two students were named Regeneron Science Talent Search Semifinalists.
- ◆ In 2021-2022, 95% of eligible seniors participated in the W.I.S.E. (Wide-ranging Interest-based Senior Experience) Program at 150 different work sites. All students presented about their experiences at the WISE Showcase at the completion of the program.

## CO-CURRICULAR HIGHLIGHTS

- ◆ In 2021-2022 *Forum* (EHS's Literary and Art Magazine) was a Gold Medal winner from the Columbia Scholastic Press Association (Columbia University).
- ◆ In 2021-2022, 40 students competed in the NYS School Music Association competition with 38 scoring an "A" or "Excellent" rating. Three students were accepted to the NYSSMA All State.

## SERVICE

- ◆ Collectively, the students of EHS provided over 600 hours of free tutoring to middle and high school student through National Honor Society and academic honor societies.
- ◆ EHS students participated in fundraising activities and raised over \$30,000 for the American Cancer Society.
- ◆ Eastchester Government Organization planned multiple blood drives, impacting 216 lives.

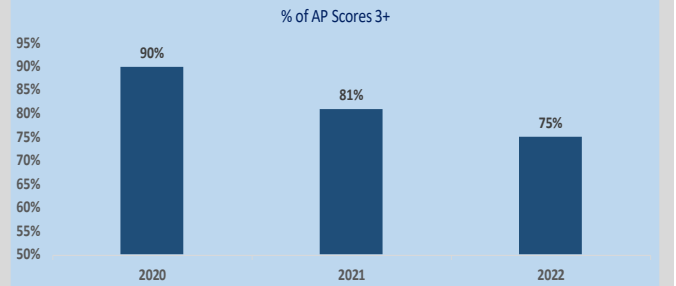
